(Created by our Reopening Team last summer)

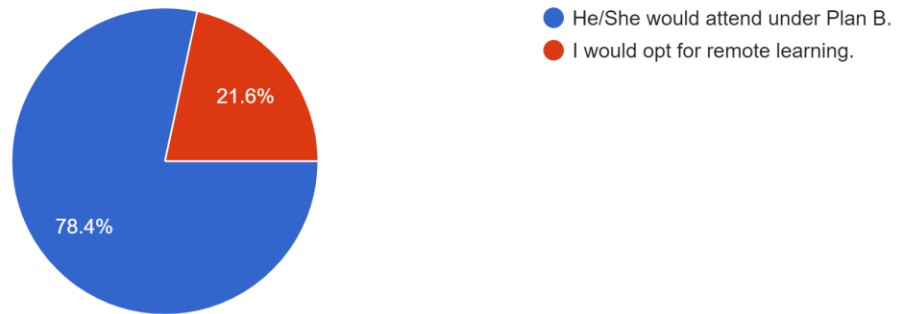
1. The health, safety, and well-being of our students and faculty are our paramount concern at all times.
2. We will base our plans on current medical, scientific, and public health expertise.
3. [Lighting Our Way Forward](#) and the [Strong Schools NC Public Health Toolkit](#) are our guidebooks for school re-opening. Woods may devise specific parts of our plans that are more stringent than those in these two documents, but [Lighting Our Way Forward](#) and the [Strong Schools NC Public Health Toolkit](#) are our baselines.
4. We will provide the most powerful and lasting learning experience for our students that conditions allow.
5. Our plans will be adaptable, flexible, and able to respond dynamically as key COVID metrics fluctuate and governmental mandates change.
6. Our families need regular, clear communication regarding the plans as they evolve.

Elementary

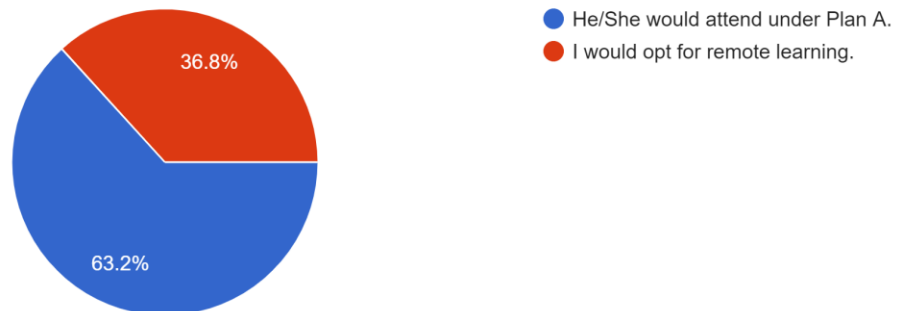
If there is an option to return to school under a hybrid Plan B (mix of in-person and remote instruction), I would choose the following for my child:

If there is an option to return four or five days a week under a Plan A (in which social distancing was recommended but not required), I would choose the following for my child:

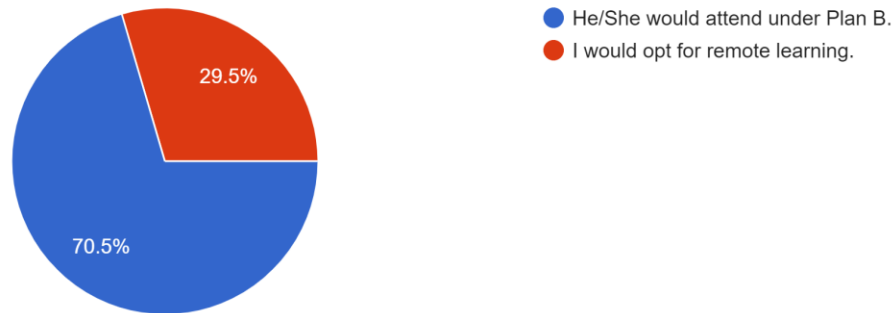

If there is an option to return to school under a hybrid Plan B (mix of in-person and remote instruction), I would choose the following for my child:

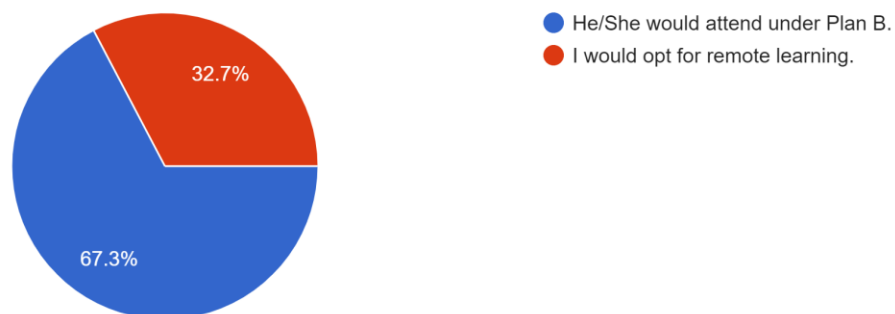
132 responses

March 15th

Grades K-2 return under Plan B

(Plan A if actual in-person numbers allow proper distancing. If so, then in-person Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. Otherwise, A and B cohorts, two days a week.)

March 22nd

Grades 3-4 return

(Plan A if actual in-person numbers allow proper distancing. If so, then in-person Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. Otherwise, A and B cohorts, two days a week.)

April 5th

Grades 5-6 return under Plan B

April 12th

Grades 7-12 return under Plan B
